The Annie Malone May Day Parade is one of the oldest and largest parades in the St. Louis area, originating in 1910. The parade for many years was held in north St. Louis City, however as the size of participants and spectators grew, it was moved to Downtown St. Louis. Today, the parade has grown to be the 2nd largest African-American parade in the country with over 3,500 participants and 30,000 spectators. The parade is the agency's largest fundraiser with proceeds covering both direct program costs and operating expenses not covered by other sources of revenue.



Located in The Ville Neighborhood of North St. Louis near Tandy Park and the Charles Sumner High School, the Annie Malone Children & Family Service Center has provided many much-needed services to families of The Ville since 1888 when the Annie Malone Children's Home was opened.

Although the chapter was hoping to have at least 25 participants in order to have a space with a decorated vehicle in the parade, the ladies of Alpha Zeta Chapter showed up in true Iota Spirit. Next year – new opportunity!









Also in held in May, our Sorors participated in the Nami Walk for Mental Health on May 13th.




May 27th Chapter Meeting and Election of 2023-2024 Officers
